Dear Crescent Family:

Wow, this is going to be an exciting year at Crescent! We are only a week into the school year and under Principal Leach's leadership, we are already witnessing incredible changes to our landscape, to our structure and to our identity as a school. Now, more than ever, is our opportunity to achieve great things by working as a team with our teachers, administrators and families to help unify the school community we want our children to experience at Crescent.

In this packet, you will find most of the tools you need to start the year off right at Crescent, including:

**PTA Meeting Schedule:** Attend our monthly PTA meetings to hear of school-wide developments from Principal Leach, and to participate in the coordination of enrichment programs and events. In this economy, the easiest way to contribute to your children's education is to volunteer your time. Any amount of time you can volunteer will make an incredible difference in the quality and quantity of programs the PTA can offer.

**PTA Membership Forms:** Our PTA membership packet is enclosed and is an important component to our effectiveness for our students, our school and our community. The PTA is a strong network comprised of over 6 million members nationally, all working together to benefit all children. **Join today** and help us strengthen our voice. **New Earthquake Kit Procedures:** We have updated the earthquake procedures this year to ensure that all Crescent students are prepared in case of an emergency at school that would require them to remain in their classrooms for extended periods of time. To that end, each child must have an emergency kit in his/her classroom, and parents can either bring in existing earthquake kits from previous years or prepare a new kit per the enclosed guidelines.

Sign up for our password-protected online directory that is only available to Crescent families. We will also be including the Crescent Business Listings this year for Crescent family-owned and operated businesses.

**ART MASTERS** – Scheduled four times per year Cost: \$6,000.00

---

This program is designed to teach children to create, understand and appreciate works of art and cultures. Students “meet” master artists at assemblies through interactive slide presentations with visiting lecturers. Then students are treated to exciting studio art lessons with their classroom teachers using artist-quality materials in the same manner as the masters!

**BIRTHDAY BOOK CLUB**

---

This is a very fun program that the PTA helps to coordinate with the school librarian to benefit our library. During the month of your child's birthday, he/she will be given the chance to pick out a brand new book of his/her choice to donate to the library. Your child's name and birth date will be placed on the inside cover of the book, and your child will be the first one to check out the book. Cost to participate: \$15.00.

**BOOK FAIR** – Offered twice per year

---

Scholastic Book Fair is a special event that enables parents and children to purchase quality books at reasonable prices, while all money raised is used to buy new books for our school library.

**BIRTHDAY CUPCAKE PARTY** – Celebrated Monthly Cost: \$250.00

---

Each month, our birthday party chairpersons host a small birthday party at snack recess on each campus to celebrate all students who have birthdays in that month. Students receive an invitation to attend and enjoy their special birthday cupcake.

**CAREER DAY** – Scheduled in the Spring Cost: \$500.00

---

Career Day is an opportunity for 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students to spend a day learning about many exciting professions and what it takes to prepare for various careers. Volunteer presenters come to the school and give informational sessions throughout the day. The students receive their individual schedule for the day, based on input they give about their interests, and they attend 6, 40 minute career sessions throughout the day.

**FAMILY NIGHTS** – Scheduled throughout the year Cost: \$200.00

---

- Family Reading Nights – Please bring the entire family for our reading nights – see calendar for details
- Family Movie Night – We are hoping to schedule at least one movie night this coming year
- Family Education Nights – Teachers host reading, science and math nights for all students

**FUN RUN** – October or November Raises: \$7,000.00

---

The Fun Run is a one-day event where kids run a ¼ mile track at school and collect pledge money from family and friends. We are trying to get corporate sponsorship for this event this year! It is a fun day with a lot of activities for the whole family and a great opportunity to interact with many of the students at school.

***I KNOW MY STATES*** –

Cost: \$500.00

---

The “I Know My States” program encourages all students to learn the names and locations of all the states in the United States. This voluntary program gives students an opportunity to take a test where they are given a map of the United States and they must fill in the state names from memory. Students who successfully fill in all state names are rewarded with a pizza party.

***IMAGINATION MACHINE*** – Throughout the year

Cost: \$2,100.00

---

A theater group performs stories written by our very own students in a very entertaining assembly format. This assembly is combined with another assembly (called Write Away) in which 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade students learn about the mechanics of writing.

***MUSIC PROGRAM*** – Throughout the year (20 times per year) for grades K-4<sup>th</sup>

Cost: \$5,300.00

---

Literacy-OnStage is a music enrichment program created by Regina Roum, a beloved music teacher, who performs an assembly about a chosen book, followed up by individual class music lessons that incorporate the story in some way. A winter concert and an end of year concert are included.

***RED RIBBON WEEK*** – October

Cost: \$1,400.00

---

Crescent participates in the annual celebration of National Red Ribbon week. Students across America commit themselves to living drug-free, healthy lives in remembrance of a DEA agent who lost his life in the fight against drugs. The PTA plans and hosts activities for the week to help convey an anti-drug message that is interesting and meaningful to students.

***REFLECTIONS PROGRAM*** – September/October

Cost: \$250.00

---

The Reflections Program is an arts recognition and achievement program for students. The Reflections Program provides opportunities for students to express themselves creatively and to receive positive recognition for original works of art inspired by pre-selected themes, while increasing community awareness on the importance of the arts in education. The program culminates in a wonderful reception where the children show their works of art. This year’s theme is “Beauty is ...”.

***SCIENCE FAIR*** – Scheduled in the spring for all grades

Cost: \$200.00

---

The Science Fair is an extraordinary learning program which has become a tradition with Crescent students. Students can partner with friends or submit an entry individually. Students attend an informational session to learn the guidelines for the projects. Next the students come up with individual science projects: they present their hypothesis, scientifically conduct testing, and then present their results. The students create a project display board and all experiments are judged and displayed at the Science Fair, an evening event for students and families. Winning entries receive a ribbon and recognition at the Science Fair and in the school newsletter. In recent years we’ve had over 100 projects entered in the Crescent Science Fair!

***SCIENCE-ON-THE-GO*** – Throughout the year for grades K-3

Cost: \$2,100.00

---

Science on the go features hands-on demonstrations with live exhibits and guest speakers each quarter. The theme for 2009-2010 Science-on-the-go is Zoology, and the lectures will be on spiders, amphibians and reptiles. It is a favorite program with students.

***SUMMER BASH*** – May/June

---

The Summer Bash is an end-of-the-year carnival for students and their families. We have food booths, game booths, music and a cake walk. Students can earn game tickets during the week preceding the event making for an exciting week and a much-anticipated carnival.

### **WALK THROUGH HISTORY** – Grades 4-6 – March/June

Cost: \$3,900.00

California Weekly Explorer specializes in live presentations that focus on 4th, 5th and 6th grade social studies covering the areas of California (4<sup>th</sup> grade), American (5<sup>th</sup> grade) and Ancient World history (6<sup>th</sup> grade). These two and a half hour presentations, known as “Walk Through Programs”, bring to life social studies using role play, vocabulary words, music and active participation of all students.

Many of the events and programs listed above rely on volunteers to make them a success. We invite you to become involved this year in the PTA. We need reliable, interested people to volunteer their time, talent, and ideas. In so doing, you will be making a valuable contribution to our students.

Dear Parent,

For all of us, the last year has been a time of turmoil, uncertainty, and anxiety. As parents, we want the best for our children—we want them to have the passion to learn, to be well-rounded, and to reach their full potential in life. We know that we are very fortunate to have our children attend Crescent Elementary, a school that was honored and recognized recently by the OC Register as one of the best elementary schools in Orange County, receiving a “Bronze Medal.”

It is to the great academic and nurturing environment at Crescent that I write today—and I do so with a sense of great urgency—to ask you to become engaged as never before in getting involved with the school. By all of us participating—whether volunteering at an event, or in the classroom; participating in one of the many fundraisers; and / or giving a personal contribution to the Crescent PTA—we can take control, display our unity, and have a positive impact on the school and in our children’s future.

I know we may feel that we cover the funding that our children receive to attend public schools through taxes; however, this is merely one portion of the school’s funding. Funding has been increasingly abandoned by the state government responsible for our local school’s core funding.

Because we are at the mercy of State and local funding and because these funds are being redirected to help balance the State’s deficit, we must do everything in our power to augment the funding necessary for our children’s education. Funds that are raised through the PTA benefit our children directly in such programs as:

- Technology in the classrooms and computer labs;
- Educational assemblies;
- Library and classroom materials; and
- Student enrichment.

To recognize that each parent’s preference of fundraising activity is varied, I am including a draft fundraising calendar on the reverse side that includes different fundraising activities that we plan to do throughout the school year, in addition to this annual campaign.

For the programs that we will continue to offer, as well as being able to provide other services and upgrades—whether technological, or in the playground—we request a \$500 tax-deductible donation from each family. (Your pledge can even be broken into monthly or quarterly payments online). We simply ask that you think of what you can provide to the future of our children when considering your gift.

To make giving easier, you can indicate your gift amount on the Payment Record Form (attached to the back of this packet) and we will send you a donation receipt for tax purposes. Additionally, you will soon be able to give online at the Crescent PTA web site ([www.crescentpta.org](http://www.crescentpta.org)).

# Important Updated Earthquake Information

Dear Parents,

An emergency or disaster can strike at any moment. We are confronted daily with the possibility of disasters like an earthquake, fire, flood, plane crash or some other disaster, both manmade and natural. As a result of such emergencies, roads may become impassable and experts predict that your child could spend up to three days at school. Your child's welfare is important to us, and in the event of an emergency such as a devastating earthquake or lock down, we must be prepared.

To extend the care provided, every child should have his or her own three-day emergency preparedness kit. The kit is stored throughout the school year in your child's classroom emergency bin. If not used, the emergency supply kit is sent home with your child on the last day of school and should be sent back the following school year.

***At this time, we are asking for you to provide an emergency kit for each child you have in attendance at Crescent Elementary School.***

1. **If you currently have an earthquake kit that has not expired**, please update the attached emergency plan form, add an updated photo if needed, and seal the updated forms in the emergency kit and return to your child's classroom immediately.
2. **If you do NOT have an earthquake kit for each child at Crescent**, you may purchase a standard kit at many local department stores, or you can assemble your own kit by following the simple directions below and return it to school immediately.

Thank you for your attention to this important issue as we pursue excellence in education and a safe and happy school year.
